Antikumar's parents noticed a patch of discoloured skin on his arm, and when it grew bigger they took him to a private healthcare clinic. Unfortunately, Antikumar was misdiagnosed with a skin condition and prescribed the wrong treatment, meaning he didn't get any better.

Thankfully, during a routine screening programme, our team visited Antikumar's home to check him and his family for undiagnosed leprosy. After noticing his symptoms, he was referred to a healthcare centre where he was diagnosed and provided with the cure for leprosy.



"I'm happy that I am now cured. My favourite subject at school is English and I enjoy playing games with my brothers".

With your support Antikumar was treated before developing a disability and he now has a bright future ahead of him, free from leprosy.
